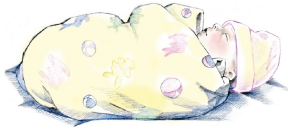

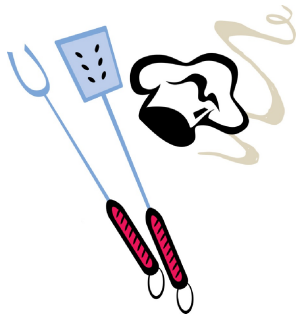
Thank you can not begin to express the appreciation I feel for my church family. All the cards, calls, visits, and well wishes have
